- **Sessions begin at 9AM, 10AM, and 11AM. Counselors may arrive early but are only required to be present during their class session(s).**
- **Merit badge class sign-up is on a first-come, first-served basis and is with the individual counselor. Please do not call the counselor prior to the Merit Badge Days.**
- **Merit badge class size is determined by each individual counselor.**
- **Merit Badge Days classes are not a guarantee of completing a merit badge within the two weeks. In fact, many badges are completed at the Merit Badge Days in 6 months or even later.**
- **Each Scout should bring: (1) A signed Blue Card from his own Scoutmaster or Troop Advancement Chairperson for each merit badge he is going to work on, (2) A copy of the merit badge pamphlet, and (3) Paper, pen and pencil. Remember, "Be Prepared"!**
- **Show Scout Spirit by wearing your Class "A" uniform or approved Troop T-shirt.**
- **At least one supervising adult per troop is required to be present so long as a Scout from that troop is participating in a class.**
