## at the Pacifica District Webelos Woods September 28-30, 2018 El Dorado East Regional Park, Long Beach

We are now seeking applications from Troops to host activity stations at the Pacifica Webelos Woods. This program is designed to be a fun and exciting way for Webelos Scouts and their parents to find out about nearby Scout troops in our District as well as the important Webelos-to-Scout transition. Webelos Woods is a great time for your Scouts to get experience in running an event, and it's also a powerful recruiting opportunity.

Either way, we need to hear from you on or before August 31st. We will hold a troop information session at Roundtable on September 18th. We recommend that you provide at least 3 adult leaders and at least 5 Boy Scouts to staff your station. While there is no fee for your Troop to participate, the park charges a vehicle admission fee of \$6 on Fridays or \$7 on weekends, CASH ONLY.

<u>OVERNIGHT CAMPING is strongly encouraged!</u> In addition to providing an opportunity for your Scouts to work on their own camping and cooking requirements during off-cycle and evening times, having Boy Scouts camping on-site provides a positive example and role models to the Webelos Scouts (and their parents) of "What we do as Boy Scouts." (It's also an ideal time for parents to stop by and ask additional questions about your Troop!) Overnight camping is available for an additional cost of \$5 per person. A meal plan is NOT available, so you will be responsible for cooking and preparing your own meals.

Please plan on arriving early enough to set up your activity — park gates open at 7:00 a.m. on Saturday. The main program is scheduled to run from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturday, with a break for lunch at around noon. We expect about 100 Webelos Scouts to attend. They will be organized into 9 patrols of 10-12 Scouts. The activity rotations are scheduled to last 30-40 minutes each, with a 10-minute "passing period" between sessions. Troops are welcome to stay for — and participate in — the Saturday evening campfire at 7:30 p.m.

While your Scouts are working on activities with the Webelos, we ask that a Scout or Scouter from your Troop discuss a "talking point" that we will assign you. In addition, we'll provide you with a simple game to teach the parents that they can take back to their Packs. This year, we will offer Troops some dedicated recruiting time in a "midway" format during an extended lunch period and afternoon free time, so there's no need for your Scouts to give your Troop's "pitch" during each activity rotation.

Once we have finalized Troop activity assignments, I will touch base with more details on what to bring, program plans, and how to take care of any minor, additional fees that may come up. If you have questions or need more information, please feel free to contact me. Thank you again for your interest. I look forward to seeing you at Webelos Woods!
