Creation of Lakota Chapter:

- The Chapter Advisers were Bob Shockley for Wyandot, Gil Arevalo for Gabrielino, and Doug Timmons for Mescalero. Wyandot was the oldest of the three Chapters.
- Council decided to merge the three Districts so the Chapters also had to merge.
- A committee of Advisers from all three Chapters met to create a plan for merger and to create a new separate Chapter, rather than absorb two into the third.
- The new Pacifica District Key-6 selected Bob Shockley from the three Advisers to serve as Adviser to the new Chapter.
- At early meetings of the new Chapter the youth adopted rules, elected Officers, and chose the Chapter name, totem, & colors.
