WEATHER HAZARDS TRAINING: This new training class, available on-line, will be **REQUIRED** by national policy in order to obtain a Tour Permit starting January 2009. From the **Council** website, click on the "Training" tab, or from the **District** website, click on "Training", then click on the link in the left column. Both will take you to the on-line learning center. In the right column is an entry titled "BSA Online Learning Center", and this is the one to click on. On the page that opens, on the right side is "HAZARDOUS WEATHER". This is it! Or you can go directly to <http://olc.scouting.org/> (it's the same place) to register and complete the course on-line. Afterward, deliver a copy of your printed certificate to the Training Chair for recording.
